Role

- To be the main point of contact for your club on all things related to COVID-19.
- Oversee the clubs implementation of public health and safety measures.
- Familiarise yourself with and implement your sports facility guidance on physical distancing and hand hygiene.
- Liaise with coach and club captain to ensure good communication with participants.
- Ensure that only those who have booked a place online prior to the activity are allowed to participate.
- At each activity take a register of participants by using the <u>Online</u> <u>Registration Form.</u>
- Inform facility of register of attendees if required.
- Encourage participants to leave facility immediately after the activity.
- Ensure that participants use hand sanitiser before and after activities.
- Ensure that participants follow physical distancing guidelines where appropriate.
- Clean equipment with disinfectant after use and store safely.
- Ensure cleaning supplies are refreshed.
