Full Time Officer Elections

Based on a review of last year's Full Time Officers (FTO) elections, it is proposed that the election voting timeframe be reduced from the 5 days to 4 days. Under this model, FTO elections would open similar to previous years at 10am on Monday 4th March 2019. However, they would close at 2pm on Thursday 7th March 2019.

The rational for this proposal is as follows:

- Candidate wellbeing Could reducing the voting period by one day reduce candidate stress? This is especially pertinent given our renewed commitment to improving mental health for all students.
- Decreases the possible amount of time that candidates (and their teams) miss out on class time.
- Stopping a day earlier assists with the operational workload of running the elections and frees up internal resources.
- Candidates will still be notified of results individually on Friday before the Big Elections Results night.

Further, our Big Student Election partners have already moved to shorter election timeframes - 3 day for Strathclyde and 4 day City of Glasgow College with both ending on Thursday (SAUWS did not respond).
