Brief Summary of Issues/Topic	We, as members of the Student Association are deeply concerned about the recent events in Palestine & Gaza involving the Israeli Government. We express our deep solidarity with the Palestinian people who have been the victim of collective punishment.  Acknowledging the stance of the Scottish Government, we believe it is our					
	moral responsibility to stand against the tragic loss of <i>all</i> innocent civilian lives, whether Israeli or Palestinian. We must also advocate for the creation of humanitarian corridors.					
	Therefore, we motion for the Student association and university governance bodies to issue a statement strongly condemning the actions of the Israeli Government, as it breaks international law as recognised by humanitarian bodies.					
	We recognise that the direct targeting of civilians should <i>never</i> be excused, extending our deepest sympathies and condolences to everyone affected. Moreover, we must highlight the government's long history of aggressively disproportionate responses and an enaction of illegal apartheid in Palestine. Therefore, these war crimes can never be justified and should not undermine the Palestinian cause for freedom and equality.					
	Furthermore, we are resolute in our stance against <b>any</b> form of discrimination including Islamophobia, Antisemitism, and racism. These have no place within our university, and we commit to maintaining an inclusive environment.					
	Let it be resolved that GCU reaffirms its commitment to promoting peace, justice, and equality for all, whilst calling the upon global community to join us in this pursuit.					
	Proposed Statement: "We recognise that the direct targeting of civilians should <i>never</i> be excused, extending our deepest sympathies and condolences to everyone affected. Moreover, we must highlight the Israeli government's long history of aggressively disproportionate responses and an enaction of illegal apartheid. These war crimes can never be justified and should not undermine the Palestinian cause for freedom and equality.
