## 3. Actions from previous meeting

- a. Re:union Bar Ugly Mug collection point is on-going (Action: Moses)
- b. Waste minimisation packs have been brought up with the Fresher's coordinators and will be explored with Fresher's Committee (Resolved)

## 4. Trimester 1 Project updates

- a. Swap Shop Group reviewed Swap Shop event. Went okay but not as busy. Clothes donated will be saved for this semester Hamish Wood in week 10 or 11. Promotion need to be more prevalent and start earlier. Fashion and/or marketing students do similar so should explore working with them. Also possibly explore working with Revolve for next Swap Shop ask them to come in and can host stall for them. Give people a direction to their outlets.
- b. Carbon Literacy Training Group reviewed. Went very well and will be working with Alec in GSBS on building a business case for GCU to permanently fund the training (Action: Moses)

- a. Refreshers Monday and Tuesday is booked. Will be a co-stall with another group and currently gathering resources for stall.
- b. Catering Issues related to E&E keep being brought up by students (e.g. Ideas). Group discussed setting up a meeting with catering (Terese Fraser) and include FTO with remit for catering. **Action: Sara**
- c. Student Voice Ideas
  - Food recycling bins Paulo reported that there were previous issues with food
    waste bins community was not sorting which thwarted recycling. So have moved
    to another approach of making recycling easy. Production areas in canteen has food
    waste collection. Group resolved to work on having communication/film about food
    recycling in the canteen (Action: Moses)
  - 2. More wildflower might be hard to implement as previous efforts the plants did not thrive. However, have planted more trees on campus
  - 3. Plastic free campus working on cutlery. Group explored the possibility of removing Styrofoam from canteens.
  - 4. Food waste donations –Paulo reported that there are issues around food hygiene that might make this unworkable.
