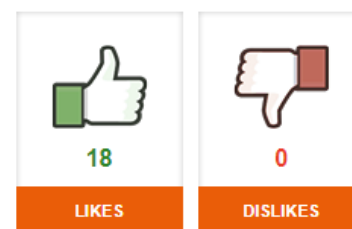


More green space to sit, walk, and chill between the lectures
