This is not a liberation group.</p> <p><b>Men's Health and Alliance Group</b></p> <p><b>Remit</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) To ensure the effective and legitimate representation of Men students to the University and externally on their student experiences, working as appropriate with the Executive Committee and Students' Association Staff.</li> <li>b) To run campaigns to support men's mental health and health in general.</li> <li>c) To ensure the Students' Association has strong connections with our Men student members, that the Students' Association establishes new methods to encourage participation and that there is an overall high student satisfaction with the Students' Association.</li> <li>d) To ensure the group champions diversity and inclusion for other liberation groups within the Equality and Diversity Committee.</li> <li>e) The Men's Health and Alliance Officer is a full member of Student Voice, Equality and Diversity Committee and is the Chair of the Men's Health and Alliance Group for which they will help recruit members each year. Also the Officer can be assisted a Deputy Officer.</li> </ul> <p><b>Men's Health and Alliance Officer</b></p> <p>The remit of the Men's Health and Alliance group will be as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Men's Health and Alliance Group should be a network to create awareness and run campaigns to support men's mental health and health in general.</li> <li>• This group should work to champion diversity and inclusion for other liberation groups within the Equality and Diversity Committee.</li> <li>• Four statutory meetings will be held through the academic year, two in Trimester 1 and two in Trimester 2.</li> </ul>
