Propose for reduction of school fees during online studies

Liasing with the school administration, I will do my best to ensure that there is a reduction in the tuition fees by students, considering the fact that the mode of studies had to be changed.

Most students study and receive lectures from home as opposed to physical learning pre-Covid. International students especially should not be made to pay as much as they were paying since studies are now online.

Propose for the reduction in GCU student accommodation fees
