

Student Voice Elected Positions 2022/23

Process of nomination: Raise your hand at the Student Voice meeting when nominations are opened to the floor for each position. Only current Student Voice members present at the meeting may stand for a position.

Process of Elections: If there are more candidates standing for a position than there are number of places, then an online election will be run. Candidates in contested elections will each have up to two minutes to address members of Student Voice at the meeting. Elections will run from Wednesday 26th October at 10am until Thursday 27th October at 12noon. Only current Student Voice members will be able to cast their ballot using single transferrable vote (STV) method. If the number of candidates equal the number of available positions, then these members shall be duly elected.

FAQ

Q. Can I stand for more than one position?

A. Yes except The Chair and Vice Chair of Student Voice who may only hold one Officer role at Student Voice so the same person may not hold the role of both Chair and Vice Chair. The Chair and Vice Chair can be representatives on other committees.

Q. What are the eligibility requirements of standing for a position?

Student Voice Elected Positions 2022/23

A. You must be a current member of Student Voice. You must remain a member for the entirety of the term of office – i.e. be a continuing GCU student for 2022/23. So if you are graduating this January. Other eligibility requirements are outlined on the grid above.

Q. What are the terms of office for the positions?

A. Term of office will begin immediately and finish at the end of Trimester 2 2023 exam diet.

Q. Can Full Time Officers stand for a position on Senate?

A. Yes. As a member of Student Voice, FTOs may stand for Senate positions.

Q. I am currently a Representation Officer, can I stand for an Open Place on the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) committee.

A. You are already a member of the EDI committee. The Open Places are for non- Rep Officers.
