	<p>Last year, we introduced a condensed voting timeframe. This was successful as we had a record breaking turnout, increased satisfaction in the candidates' survey and positive comments from the Returning Officer on the 2 stage complaints processes that was facilitated by this change. Therefore, we will again be running a 4-day voting period.</p> <p>Changes this year include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nominations open in Refreshers week of Trimester 2 instead of in Trimester 1. • A separate manifesto deadline – candidates can nominate themselves without submitting a manifesto initially. • Manifesto training – more help for candidates in preparing for elections • Last year we introduced official photos to be used on the voting platform. This was successful and has been written into this year's timetable. • Candidate filming and candidate training have been written into the timetable for added clarity. <p>We will be part of the Big Elections group again this year comprising of Strathclyde, GCU and UWS. City of Glasgow College run on a different academic calendar and will not be part of the Big Elections group this year. The results party will be at UWS.</p> <p>It is the role of the Deputy Returning Officer to decide the timeframe for the NUS Conferences Elections and Full Time Officer Elections.</p>
