	Our By-Laws allow for a successfully elected candidate, called a Full T			
	Officer-elect, to be able to	o resign with four weeks o	of being elected and for	or
	their place to be filled by the next placed candidate. It is proposed to extend this period to 10 weeks, as this would be before a Full Time Officer starts their Handover and Induction and prevents the need for a By- Election. A By-Election usually has lower voter turnout and is therefore not			
	as democratically rigorous as the Full Time Officers elections held during			
	term-time.

	then this vacancy can be filled by the next placed candidate.
