IF ELECTED I WILL;

1. **PROMOTE THE 'ASK THE OFFICER'** facility on a **weekly basis** to help **identify issues on a regular basis**, which will help represent you, the student, as best as possible. I have seen first-hand how much your officers do for you behind the scenes, however, I aim to make them more visible and accessible to you, the student who elected them!
2. **FREE CONDOMS** extended to evening hours. I aim to work with the Advice Centre on extending existing hours for free condoms from class-time hours (9-5) to evening-hours to keep students safe at **ALL** times!
3. **REDUCE GRADUATION FEES** -Having to pay £50 to graduate when your SAAS payments have stopped, even if you don't go to the ceremony, is putting students into hardship-especially if you don't have a job waiting for you upon graduation! I aim to work on your behalf for the fee to be reduced for people attending the ceremony and drastically reduced for graduates who don't attend, including the ability to pay any charges in instalments.
4. **MAKE MENTAL HEALTH A PRIORITY ESPECIALLY DURING EXAM TIME-** If, like me, you are one of the students who just don't like exams, then you will welcome my pledge of campaigning for additional help for students to cope with the stress of exams including study skills support and how to manage stress effectively as well as help all year round for anxiety, depression and other mental health issues!
