

Student Voice Elected Positions 2023/24

Opening date of nominations: Monday 12th February 2024

Process of nomination: Email Studentvoice@GCUStudents.co.uk stating which position(s) you would like to stand for OR raise your hand at the Student Voice meeting when nominations are opened to the floor for each position. Only current Student Voice members may stand for a position.

Closing date of nominations: Monday 19th February. Final call for nominations will take place at the meeting of Student Voice.

Process of Elections: If there are more candidates standing for a position than there are number of places, then an online election will be run. Elections will run from Wednesday 21st February at 10am until Thursday 22nd February at 12noon. Only current Student Voice members will be able to cast their ballot using single transferrable vote (STV) method. If the number of candidates equal the number of available positions, then these members shall be duly elected. A subsequent election will be held at the next meeting of Student Voice 2023/24 for any unfilled positions.

Position	Description	Number of places
Senate Student Representative	University committee responsible for overall planning, co-ordination, development and supervision of the academic work of the University. Meets 6x a year. More information here . The Student Senators will be responsible for inputting the student voice into Senate. Senate meetings can be long and paper heavy so there is a substantial commitment.	1x Open
Learning Enhancement Subcommittee Student Representative	Committee responsible for ensuring the effective implementation and monitoring of university quality assurance and enhancement agenda. This committee meets 4x a year. More information here . This committee is paper heavy but more discussion based than Senate.	1x Open
Elections Committee	The Elections Committee is responsible for supporting the roles of the Returning and Deputy Returning Officer. No member of the Elections Committee can take part in the Full Time Officers elections as a candidate, agent or campaigner. They would have to resign from the elections committee.	3x
